

**Daily trips around Brda**

**Sabotin - Gradno - Dobrovo - Šmartno**

**Beautiful views & First World War on the Hill of Sabotin**  
**Olive oil tasting & Wine tasting**



*Hill of Sabotin*

Our first stop is the **hill of Sabotin** (609 m). Besides the **marvelous view** the hill offers a number of natural and cultural attractions. We visit a small **museum collection of the First World War**, followed by a **guided tour through the military caverns**. On our way towards the village called Gradno we stop at the **olive oil tasting**, where we learn about olive-growing tradition in the Brda. In Gradno we visit the church of St. George. This tiny church hides inside two artistic gems: via Crucis by the world renowned painter **Zoran Mušič** and frescoes by **Lojze Spacal**. On our way back to the bus we pass by the **oldest olive grove in Brda**. A short drive will bring us to the largest wine cellar in Slovenia. **Guided tour of the cellar, wine tasting with refreshment**, followed by lunch with **seasonal dishes of the Brda cuisine**. We continue our trip to the **medieval village of Šmartno**. A typical Mediterranean village is one of the best preserved villages in the coastal region. We visit the majestic Church of St. Martin, ethnological museum *Briška hiša*, Brda house, and the house of culture. Free time for coffee, opportunity to purchase souvenirs. The trip ends by the **lookout tower in Gonjače** with astonishing views over the whole Brda region, Julian and Carnian Alps, until the Adriatic sea.

- Recommendation: suitable footwear for the rocky terrain (hill Sabotin)
