'Learn Devanagari Script'

Devanagari is a script of India and Nepal. It is written from left to right, does not have distinct letter cases, and is recognisable (along with most other North Indic scripts, with a few exceptions like Gujarati and Oriya) by a horizontal line that runs along the top of full letters. It is almost 2500 years old very scientific script, devided into vowels and consonants in a proper systematic linguistic fashion.

The goal of the Workshop is to learn this script in 5 weeks (each week 90 minute workshop) - first week for vowels, 2nd and 3rd week for consonants, 4th week to write root sounds and 5th week to write vowel and consonants together. This way a learner can read and write almost in all major languages of India. This can be specially useful to tourists to read instruction in India and will extremely beneficial to cultural exchanges. Our lecturer is prof. dr. Arun Prakash Mishra, ph.d.
